The Southwest Conference on Asian Studies will hold its 49th Annual Meeting in October of 2020. Celebrating the successful conclusion of our program, we are calling for papers to be considered for publication in our journal in 2021. Submissions may fall into either of the two categories below.

- 1) For conference participants, we invite submission of revised versions of the papers presented at any SWCAS annual meeting. Papers should be between 5,000 and 10,000 words (including bibliography and footnotes), should follow the conventions of the American Psychological Association (APA) citation style, 7th Edition, and be prepared for blind review. All works should have a 100-word abstract, with a list of 5 keywords. Each participant should send only one paper.
- 2) For anyone working in the field of Asian Studies whose base of operations is in the geographical region covered by our conference (loosely defined), but who have not presented at a SWACS conference previously, unpublished papers on topics relevant to the themes of this year's conference will also be considered for publication. Information on the topics addressed at this year's conference are available in the conference program at our website, <https://www.swcas.net>.

Proposals will be collected until **December 31, 2020**. The works will be submitted to peer-review before being accepted for publication. The editors may request changes in content and style by author/s of the papers. All submissions may be sent to Dr. Stephen Leach at stephen.leach@utrgv.edu.
